## Liskow & Lewis Law Firm

Accessible by only a single door, this open-air atrium on the third floor proved especially challenging during the installation. It required hand-carrying all of the plants to their proper locations on the 2-foot ledge.

Ample color is introduced with pink anthuriums, bromeliads, *Croton 'Rasta,'* *Dracaena 'Limelight,'* variegated *Schefflera arboricola,* variegated English ivy and *Dracaena Warneckii 'Lemon Lime.'*

In a corner setting, braided *Dracaena marginata* underplanted with golden pothos and a bromeliad draws the eye.

Along the wall, a large false aralia serves as the centerpiece, flanked by pink anthuriums, variegated *S. arboricola,* Neoregelia and Guzmania bromeliads. Small donger bromeliads and *Sansevieria cylindrica* accent the base.
